Advisers to NEOM on the world's first green hydrogen / ammonia export megaproject to commence construction, involving 4GW of solar and wind and a 2GW electrolyser in Saudi Arabia with Air Products (USA) and ACWA Power (KSA). The project will come onstream in 2026. Capex is US\$6.5 billion.
